### Academic Assistance

GED & high school tutoring, scholarship research, & help with college & vocational school enrollment.

### Counseling

Bilingual professional counselors.

### Mentoring

Meet weekly with a supportive and caring adult.

### Case Management

A caring adult who will help you reach your goals.



### Jobs for Life

Job readiness classes and assistance from a job developer.

### Paid Work Experience

Paid, on-the-job training.

### Community Service

For character development and probation/parole.

### Moms Place

Parenting skills and support for teenage mothers.

### Life Skills

Financial education & healthy relationship classes.

### Field Trips and Incentives

For reaching personal goals.
